### The Organization:

- Is a nonprofit voluntary benefit association which provides supplemental benefits to federal employees and retirees, military, and contractors assigned to NSA-W
- Established in 1957 and now has almost 17,000 members worldwide
- Launched GEBA Wealth Management in October 2017 to offer financial planning services and investment products delivered by licensed and credentialed professionals with specific knowledge of federal benefits
- Introduced the Sponsored Family Member Program in November 2014 and extended eligibility for most GEBA products and services to a member's extended family (siblings, parents, grandparents, adult children, and adult grandchildren)

### Products and Services:

- Offers a variety of high-quality group insurance coverage from respected providers, including dental, vision, life insurance, disability, and professional liability coverage
- Gives unbiased insurance and financial planning advice from licensed Financial Advisors, including CERTIFIED FINANCIAL PLANNER™ professionals and Chartered Federal Employees Benefit Consultants (ChFEBC<sup>SM</sup>)
- Provides the most sought-after financial products in the marketplace, including options not widely available to the public, as well as portfolio management services
- Provides member discounts on MetLife Auto and Home®, Nationwide® Veterinary Pet Insurance, and Long Term Care Insurance

### GEBA Scholarship Foundation:

- Established in 2005 to provide scholarships to members and their families as a way of honoring members through educational opportunities
- Since inception, have awarded 375 merit-based scholarships totaling \$825,000 to support full-time students pursuing a post-secondary accredited program since its inception
- Introduced the Member Appreciation Educational Award Program (MEAP) in 2012 to support educational assistance to members who work full time while pursuing a degree part-time. In 2014, the GEBA Board of Directors added student debt repayment option to the award program
- Will award up to 40 scholarships and up to 10 MEAP awards each valued at \$2,500 in 2019.
