The following applies to Alaska residents:

For the purpose of changing the maximum number of days New York Life must send a claimant a claim form after notice of claim to 10 days, the Claim Forms section of the Claims provision in the Important Notice and General Provisions page(s) is revised as follows:

Claim Forms New York Life will send the claimant claim forms within 10 days after notice of claim is received. If New York Life does not send the forms within 10 days, the claimant can send written proof of claim. The claim form or proof must show the date, cause and extent of the loss.
